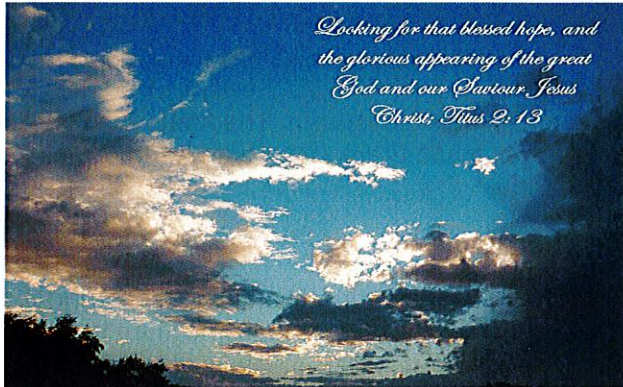

"We envision the young being filled with the hope of Jesus and changing their generation forever." Foundations for Nations is a new ministry based on an Indian Reserve in Wyoming. The Native American culture is full of unemployment, sexual abuse, and depression. Jason and Sarah (brother and sister-in-law of Kevin Lucas) have begun programs to change the way that Native Americans live. Some of the programs include sewing and cooking classes, sports camps, tutoring, discipling, vbs, bible studies, a feeding program, and a church. They have big plans for this ministry, and God has even bigger plans! They moved out to the reserve in June 2017.

Young Woman Rejected by Family for Following Christ

A young woman experienced persecution from her family for her newfound faith in Christ. Divine accepted Christ after a front-line worker shared the gospel in her village. Shortly after she became a Christian, her family began to beat her and refused to give her any food to eat. They tried to force her to recant and return to worshipping their traditional gods. When she would not give up Christ, they told her she was no longer part of their family and kicked her out of their house. The front-line worker provided Divine with a place to live and helped her with educational expenses and supplies to become a tailor. "I could not give up Jesus because Jesus my Lord and gave me a new life," Divine said. "My most important prayer request would be that I want my family to know Christ and that I could lead them to Christ."

Pastor's Wife Advances the Gospel While Hospitalized

A pastor's wife has led over 30 patients to Christ and shared the gospel with many more while hospitalized to receive cancer treatment. Nguyen Thanh and her husband have dedicated their lives to advancing God's kingdom among remote villages throughout Vietnam. During their ministry, they have experienced persecution, being beaten and detained for preaching the gospel to many different tribal groups. Then, Nguyen was diagnosed with cancer in 2011, and her cancer relapsed in 2020, requiring a complicated surgical procedure and hospitalization. Because of coronavirus protocols, she was required to stay at the hospital for an extended amount of time. During her stay, she has shared the gospel with more than 100 patients, and 32 have responded in faith. She has also been teaching the Bible to the new believers, and many of them have returned home and are sharing the gospel in their communities. Pray for these believers to continue growing in their faith. Pray also for Nguyen and her husband, thanking God for their faithful witness to Christ and asking for their material and physical needs to be met as she continues to recover.
